Bursaries will be presented for the following areas:

- 1 x Academic Bursary
- 1 x Sporting Bursary
- 1 x Cultural Bursary
- 1 x STEM (Science, Technology, Engineering and Mathematics)

Criteria

Applicants must attend a primary school in the Fraser Coast district in Year 6, and be recommended by their primary school for these Bursaries. Bursary holders will receive their benefits for Year 7 at Maryborough State High School.

Guidelines

Bursary applications will be processed by a panel and the recipients will be presented at a special ceremony. The decision of the panel will be final, and no correspondence may be entered into. Late applications will not be considered.

A Maryborough State High School Bursary will entitle the student to the following:

- (a) School's Resource Scheme Fees (\$180 technology scheme and access to the Bring Your Own Device Network -\$25)
- (b) Their name on the school's Bursary Honour Roll

Additional Information

- Applicants may select one or more areas of excellence, and be considered for that category
- Applicants must complete attached forms and submit a 200 word essay about their area of excellence, abilities and goals
- All applications will be kept confidential
- Applications close 30 September, 2022
- Recipients announced 31 October, 2022
