<p>Creative Industries Prefect Years 10-12</p> <p>Facilitated by HOD Creative Industries</p>	<p>Roles and Responsibilities</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Oversees and supervises all activities for the Arts in the school • Reports to HOD Creative Industries • Organises school parades with assistance of HOD PSC and HOD Creative Industries • Advocates for the Arts in the school • Works with the HOD Creative Industries to create an annual Arts Plan • Organises Creative Industries activities during lunchtimes • School service: Good Morning Start program and/or Tuckshop as rostered • Attends Year 7 Connect Classes every Wednesday Term 1
<p>SRC President Year 11 or 12</p> <p>Facilitated by Senior Teacher</p>	<p>The SRC is a conduit for all students having a voice and being active participants in the Maryborough SHS community. Focuses on fundraising for school needs and local, national and international charities</p> <p>Roles and Responsibilities</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Represent the student body at school, district, and civic meetings • Develop agenda for and preside at student council meetings • Knowledge of the basic rules of parliamentary procedure • Displays academic integrity and exemplary conduct • Fundraising • School service: Good Morning Start program and/or Tuckshop as rostered • Attend Year 7 Connect Classes every Wednesday Term 1 • Attend P & C Meetings on a monthly rotation • Completes SRC Student report for P & C as required • Attend Fraser Coast Leadership breakfast once per term
