He enlisted as a Lieutenant and assigned to the 9<sup>th</sup> Battalion being the first Battalion ashore at Gallipoli. He was promoted to Captain in 1915 seeing action in Egypt to defend the Suez Canal. In 1916 Duncan was transferred to the 45<sup>th</sup> Battalion and promoted to Major seeing action on the Western Front.

**Duncan was Killed in Action 6/8/1916 at Pozieres in France aged 28 years.**

Prior to enlisting Eric listed his occupation as a Farmer. He served with the 25<sup>th</sup> Battalion embarking Sydney per *Demosthenes* on 23/12/1916 seeing action on the Western Front. Eric was wounded by gunshot to the arm and back.

**Eric was Killed in Action 20/9/1917 in Belgium aged 25 years.**

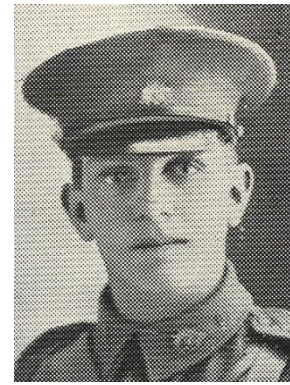

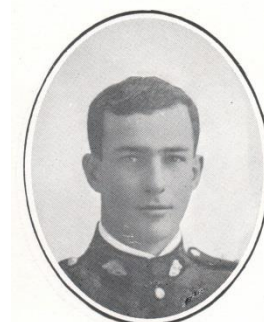
