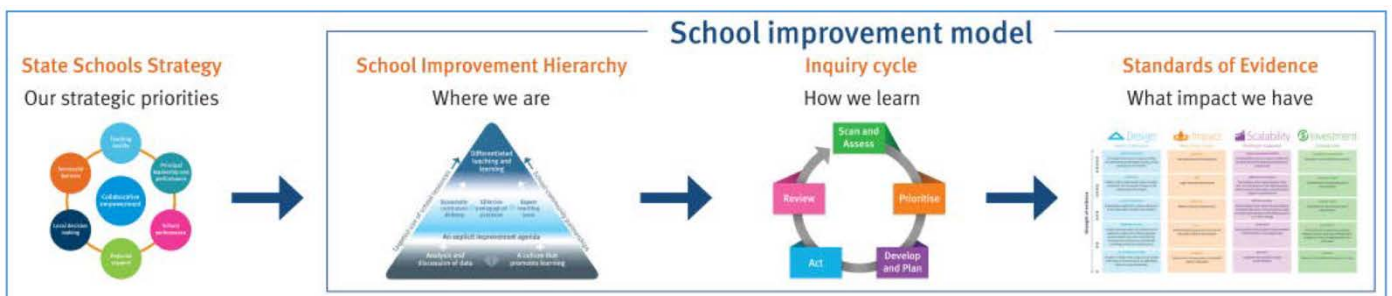


# Investing for Success

**\$439,909\***



## This funding will be used to

- Increase the percentages of students receiving A-C in Mathematics, Science and English to greater than 80%
- Increase student attendance to greater than 90%
- Maintain results of Numeracy and Reading at equal to or greater than similar Queensland Schools
- Improve the teaching of reading in a differentiated manner their targeted intervention and extra support in classrooms
- Maintain 100% of students attaining a Queensland Certificate of Education by the end of Year 12
- Improve Upper 2 Band results for students in Year 7 and 9 NAPLAN testing in all strands
- Continue to develop the confidence of the Fraser Coast Community in State Education
- Develop targeted strategies for the betterment of student and staff wellbeing, including strategies for disengaged students
- Improve capacity for innovative methods for curriculum engagement in 21<sup>st</sup> Century Skills and pedagogies

## Our initiatives include

- Employ and train teacher aides in reading comprehension strategies in Year 7 – 9 Literacy
- Engage attendance officer to monitor and implement strategies for improved attendance
- Engage Youth Support Coordinator to assist in strategies for disengaged students
- Engage School Wellbeing Coach for student wellbeing program, developed with neuroscience and social development programs (Reboot, PBL), as well as proactively work with staff
- Provide improvements to the school physical environment to engage learners and bolster confidence in public education
- Invest in technology services and infrastructure to improve the usage of digital pedagogy in the classroom
- Engagement of teacher aides to assist in proactive strategies to maximise the learning environment for all students

# Investing for Success

## Our school will improve student outcomes by

### Attendance and Engagement

- Providing extrinsic motivation for improvement in 'relative gain' in attendance - \$10 000
- Engaging students with extension and engineering programs via the school's participation in the Human Powered Vehicle program - \$13 000
- Providing opportunities for students to engage with extra-curricular activities by providing school-leased buses for student transport - \$40 000
- Monitoring and tracking of engagement and attendance through enlistment of attendance and engagement officers - \$128 000
- Provision of a Student Welfare Youth Worker and aide for student disengagement - \$25 000
- Provision of a School Wellbeing Coach (0.6 FTE) - \$75 000
- Funds for engagement in extra-curricular activities for school-based activities - \$9 000
- Staff development for engagement in the Positive Behaviour for Learning (PBL) program - \$8 000
- Development of student and staff wellbeing programs - \$5 000
- Development of resources and programs for re-engagement programs for students - \$5 909
- Acquisition of innovative technologies for engagement in learning in 21<sup>st</sup> Century pedagogy - \$13 000

### Effective Teaching

- Provision of additional teaching time (0.1 FTE) for Instrumental Music teaching and Specialist Programs Director - \$12 000
- Purchase of digital technology for staff usage to develop student usage in classes - \$10 000
- Provision of bus licenses for staff - \$2 000

### Learning


- Subscription for staff to participate in New Pedagogies for Deep Learning International Program - \$4 000

- Provision of intensive teacher aides to enhance reading outcomes - \$55 000
